Please remember to **LABEL** all of your child's belongings. This will help staff in returning lost items to students.

### **Suggested Items for Kindergarten:**

- Backpack: large enough to hold snow clothes, folders, books, lunch
- No backpacks with wheels, handles/frames
- Gym shoes: labeled and to be left at school
- Art shirt: labeled and left at school
- Box of graham crackers (for class use)
- Daily **healthy** snack
- Kleenex
- **Four** glue sticks
- **Three** bottles of glue (4-oz. size)

### **Needed Items for First Grade:**

### **Suggested Items for Fourth/Fifth Grade:**

For Personal Use:

- 1-inch, 3-ring binder for ELA
- 1-inch, 3-ring binder for Math
- 1-inch, 3-ring binder for Social Studies/Science
- **Two** pockets folders
- **Two** spiral notebooks
- **One** bound notebook with grid/graph paper instead of lined paper (often found at office supply stores, Walmart, etc.)
- Pencil pouch or small box (easily carried from class to class)
- Highlighters (several colors)
- Glue or glue sticks
- Colored pencils
- Scissors
- Hand-held pencil sharpener
- Ear buds
- Backpack (for to/from home/school)
- Gym shoes

Other Ideas/To Share With the Classroom:

- Markers and/or crayons
- Mini hand sanitizer for personal use
- Ruler (inches/mm)
- Inexpensive calculator
- Kleenex
- Sticky Notes
- Disinfectant Wipes
- Pencils
- Ziploc Bags (snack, sandwich, or gallon size)
