5 proposal recap:

## 1- Sarah Eichenberger, School Garden Proposal

NMC may be willing to partner with Eastern on a garden (Sarah is communication with Carrie at NMC). Concerns about who takes care of the garden when school is not in session. Lutes definitely thinks the teachers would be interested in the garden being a science curriculum add on...and summer camp participation possibly as well. PTO could set up a garden committee going forward. Nelson has run an ecology club in the past, so upper El could likely take this on. Funding for this could also fall under Enrichment (up to \$1500 set aside). Student Council also has some funds and could donate through their legacy project.

2- Lindsey Schulert, Air Purifiers for classrooms (\$5828)

We need to check TCAPS health policy before this can move forward (Biz). PTO would own and be responsible to upkeep of the filters.

3- Jessica Owen, Wagons (removed from the running)

concerns about space for storing the wagons, etc. We will look at a less bulky option.

4- Keelan McNulty, Playground upgrades

small immediate improvements in proposal, long term- shade and music area

teachers- would like permanent soccer goals that cannot be moved

Keelan met with Tyson Birch, head of tcaps grounds. We already started a work order to put up metal posts fo a shade structure. PTO only needs to pay for the shade canopy. (biz has a donation of 3 benches as well) 5- Lydia Potthoff, Outdoor Learning Space

Can we combine proposals with Keelan's space and have a shaded space on the playground or another space on campus? TCAPS ground manager option has made this a much less expensive proposal. Tyson is on board to install secured seating.
