

What is the TCAPS Student Support Network (SSN)?

The Student Support Network (SSN), formerly known as STEP, is a program administered by Traverse City Area Public Schools that provides free supportive, educational-related services to students, ages 3-20, to effectively nurture and support students whose non-academic needs may create obstacles to learning.

Why is the SSN necessary?

- Nearly 40% of area families qualify for free and reduced meals.
- Over 200 TCAPS students lack a fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime residence.
- Students whose basic needs have not been met are often unprepared to learn.

How does the SSN work?

- A TCAPS staff member identifies a student's need and completes a form to describe the need and urgency level.
- The district SSN Coordinator monitors and works to fulfill requests via human service agencies, community businesses, independent donors or the SSN operating budget.

What would my donation support?

- In the 2021-2022 school year, \$19,246.66 of SSN funds supported students in need.
- Needs include: school supplies, snacks, winter gear, shoes, clothing, performing arts or athletic fees, BATA passes, school photos, toiletries, grocery and gas gift cards and more.
