

**“OPT-OUT” NOTICE REQUIRED BY
“NO CHILD LEFT BEHIND” ACT OF 2001**

Federal law requires the school district, upon request, to release the name, home address and telephone number of all high school students to military recruiters unless the student or the student’s parent/guardian have directed the school not to release this information. If you do NOT want the school district to release this information to military recruiters, fill out and return the form below. This form must be filled out every year and returned to the school’s registrar. Once received, the student’s name will be removed from the list of student names released to military recruiters.
